The cost is \$50 per child. This fee covers VNA insurance until the end of 2014, A Net Set Go pack from Netball Victoria as well as skills and fun.

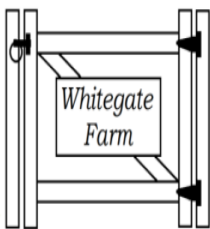
